

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. It is the customer's responsibility not to overload the container (not above the top rails) and to acknowledge that Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. drivers will not accept containers that are overloaded or unsafe to transport.
2. The customer and Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. acknowledge their responsibility under the Ontario Ministry of Environment for the correct handling, transportation and disposal of all waste.
3. Doors of the container must be closed and secured prior to pick up.
4. Unacceptable items include but are not limited to; hazardous materials, gas/propane cylinders, barbeque cylinders, paint cans, and oil products.
5. Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. will not be liable if service is not completed due to unforeseen circumstance, including weather and road closures.
6. The customer will not hold Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. responsible for any harm arising to persons due to the material in the container.
7. The customer shall provide a suitable and accessible site for the location of the container. Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. shall not be liable for any damages resulting from service save in the event of negligence of the employee.
8. Rental fees are due before delivery of the container.
9. Additional lift/rental fees will apply if the container is overloaded or contains hazardous waste.
10. Additional lift/rental fees will apply if the container has not moved within fourteen (14) days.
11. All materials placed in container become the property of Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd.
